

Part time Resident Student Intern Opportunity

University Baptist Church, aligned with the American Baptist Churches of Michigan and located in East Lansing, MI is currently seeking a part-time (10 – 12 hours per week) Campus Ministry Intern. The intern will be encouraged to attend UBC worship services, church events and Diaconate meetings and will be responsible for the following tasks:

1. Work closely with the Pastor and Diaconate to develop and implement a team approach to student opportunities within the church.
 - A. Establish students in the truths of Christianity
 - B. Lead a weekly UBC student group
 - C. Design and develop semester service projects
 - D. Accompany Pastor to MSU Religious Advisors Meetings
2. Steward of Home and Church
 - A. Member of lawn team responsible for weekly mowing (in season) east of the driveway
 - B. Snow removal on walkways at the church
 - C. Nightly security check for church

Desired Experience

The successful candidate must profess and exhibit a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord. Belief in the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Holy Trinity and Christian maturity are required. Experience in evangelism, discipleship and Bible study is desired. The intern may be either an undergraduate or graduate student and be single (living alone) or married.

Terms of Employment

This is a 1 year, renewable position with 3 weeks of annual leave to be taken during school breaks. The fulfillment of duties is anticipated to range 10 -12 hours per week. Different seasons of the year require different hours, but 12 hours a week is average. Flexibility, many nights and an ability to travel are all required. In lieu of monetary reimbursement the intern will have sole occupancy of a 5 bedroom, 2 bath, two-story home located on the church grounds. The church will pay 50% of electric, water/sewage and propane bills.
