

MICHIGAN BAPTIST SCHOLARSHIP SOCIETY (MBSS) INITIAL APPLICATION FOR CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR

Applicants must complete and sign this application and also provide the following:

1. A letter from your pastor or the governing body of your church indicating your membership in an ABC/Michigan church, together with a recommendation stating the reasons you merit MBSS scholarship support.
2. Copy of an official transcript from the most recent school attended.
3. Letter of reference from a teacher, professor, or other official from a current or recent school.
4. Copy of the official letter of acceptance from the school you will attend.
5. A typed or computer-generated autobiographical essay (usually two or three pages) describing your Christian experience, call to professional church vocation, and career goals.
6. A recent photograph. (A five to ten minute video presentation about yourself or a personal interview with the MBSS Board or a Board Member is encouraged, but not mandatory).
7. Applicants to an accredited non-ABC Christian school must submit a copy of the institution's theological values and mission statement (usually found in its catalog). MBSS will review these to assure compatibility with ABC core beliefs and practices.
8. (For seminary and other graduate school applicants only): A letter from Dr. Michael Williams, ABC of Michigan Executive Minister, indicating that you contacted him (by letter and phone if not in person) about your present plans and circumstances.
