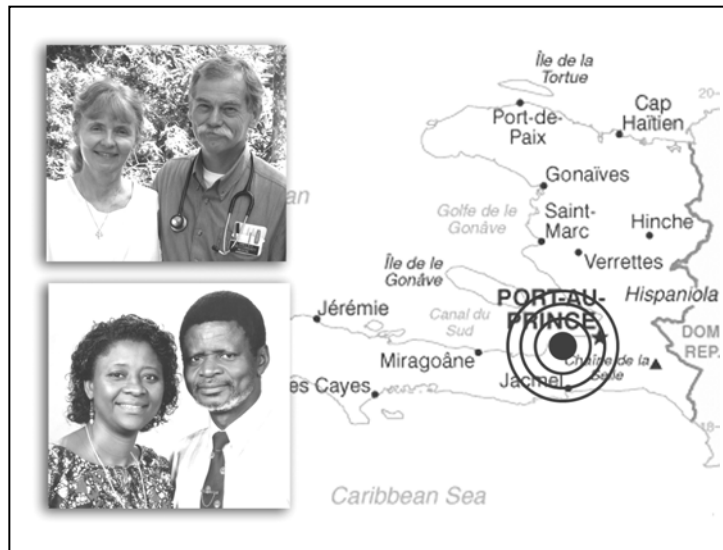


HAITI EARTHQUAKE CRISIS RESPONSE

Help Still Needed

RELIEF AND ASSESSMENT PHASE

- ❑ In the first week alone IM released **\$65,000** from One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) funds for immediate earthquake response.
- ❑ **Dr. Steve James** and our Haitian partners are providing medical care and relief supplies at the quake epicenter, southwest of Port-au-Prince, while **Nancy James** in Cap Haitien is maintaining communications.
- ❑ **Kristy Engel, Ketly and Vital Pierre and Madeline Flores-López** are IM missionaries in the Dominican Republic (DR). Kristy and the Pierres have traveled across the border to administer 3 clinics and lead a 30-person medical team. Madeline has remained in the DR to provide medical care to victims being brought to Santo Domingo.
- ❑ IM administrative staff, missionaries and partners are developing a **three-year plan** for recovery and rebuilding phases.



The headquarters of our partner, the Haitian Baptist Convention, is in the north and has been coordinating the response to the January 12th earthquake. Nancy and Dr. Steve James and Kihomi Ngwemi and Nzunga Mabudiga are International Ministries missionaries to Haiti.

YOUR HELP NEEDED
