Our 2022 conference project is knitting or crocheting hats for kids (ages 3-18) being treated for cancer. If you need a pattern, please contact Laurel Reed (Ireed4624@comcast.net) and specify knit or crochet pattern or find your own on line. Hobbii.com as well as other sites have many patterns that may be downloaded for free.

Please only use soft baby yarn (virgin yarn graded 9-12, Caron brand for example) for the Cancer recipients. Chemo and other skin disorders make the skin really thin so anything but the softest yarn will cut the scalp. Maggie's Wigs 4 Kids of MI based out of St. Clair Shores usually services about 90% girls and 10% boys with comfort bags which include games and travel pillows, for example.

Should you prefer to use another quality of yarn that you already have, the hats can still go to other hospitals, senior centers and homeless shelters.

IF YOU DON'T KNIT OR CROCHET, we'll be making 48x60 knotted fleece blankets at conference to keep patients warm when transporting to and from chemotherapy.

Collection of completed projects will be at the 2022 conference in DeWitt.



URGENT: Hurricane Response in Puerto Rico
